

Report and Minutes of Meeting held on 10/06/2019

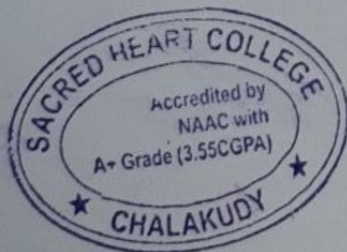

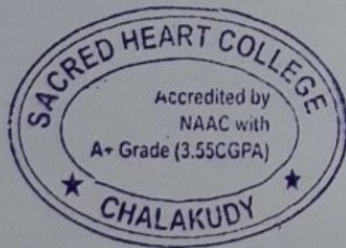



Report and Minutes of Meeting held on 04/10/2021

The Anti-Ragging committee has met in order to discuss the preparedness of the college to welcome the first year students for regular offline classes in the college. Even though the classes were started earlier, the students were in the online mode.

Important matter of discussion were

1. To give awareness to the senior and junior students.
2. To fix a session in the student induction programme to introduce anti-ragging committee and the regulations.
3. To arrange sessions for interactions between seniors and juniors.
4. The pressure of students during the online classes were also discussed. This may lead to psychological difficulties for many students from which ragging cases may evolve.

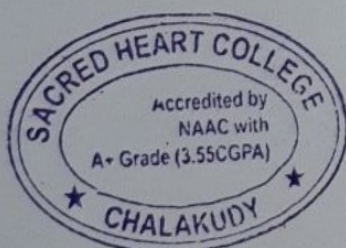
