Report of the programme

COVID-19 is an unprecedented global crisis, with researchers and healthcare professionals urgently organising to meet the demands it has caused. During the COVID-19 pandemic, mandatory social distancing and the lack of effective treatments has made telemedicine the safest interactive system between patients, both infected and uninfected, and clinicians. Telemedicine, which enables video or phone appointments between a patient and their health care practitioner, benefits both health and convenience. More health care providers are offering to “see” patients by computer and smartphone. Although cured completely of Covid-19, many survivors of the deadly pandemic are facing severe mental distress following the harrowing experience and that's where the importance of tele counselling pops in.

Sacred Heart College NSS Unit in association with IQAC took a step to ease the situation, a telemedicine and telecounselling hotline number were opened for students and public where they could seek help from the professionals in case of any physical or mental illness they feel. The Counselling service was started on 26th May onwards. Four students coordinated the programme by visiting the doctors to seek their participation in the service.



Dr.Prajeesh - Patients with mild symptoms were reported. Suggestions for good food were given.

Ms. Juliet - The main issues reported were not directly related to Covid, but the lack of confidence, symptoms of depression, tension etc. Tips were given to overcome the issues. Symptoms like depression were advised for follow ups.
