# **BASIC MATHEMATICS**

# Bridge Course offered by the Department of Economics Sacred Heart College, Chalakudy

The Department of Economics, Sacred Heart College, Chalakudy, is one of five colleges under the University of Calicut that offers the 'Mathematical Tools for Economics' as a complementary course for the BA Economics programme. The core papers for BA Economics 'Quantitative Methods for Economic Analysis' and 'Mathematical Economics' also have mathematical content. Though this is an advantage for the students undergoing the programme, there is a challenge involved. Most of the students who opt for the BA Economics Programme are those who opted for the Humanities group for higher secondary, for which Mathematics is not offered as a subject. Besides, it is a general trend that students who do not like Mathematics opt for the humanities group for higher secondary. The department felt the need to offer a bridge course in Basic Mathematics for first-year degree students. The objective of the bridge course is to refresh the basic mathematics, arithmetic and algebra the student has studied at the school level and to develop the adequate background skill in mathematics to pursue the complimentary course 'Mathematical Tools for Economics' and also the core course 'Quantitative Methods for Economic Analysis. The A bridge course for the first-year students is conducted every year during the first two semesters outside the regular working hours as a 20-hour course during the zero hours. A syllabus is framed for the bridge course by the Department of Economics.

#### BASIC MATHEMATICS

#### SYLLABUS OF THE BRIDGE COURSE OFFERED TO I BA STUDENTS

**Objective:** To refresh the basic mathematics, arithmetic and algebra the student has studied at the school level and to develop the adequate background skill in mathematics.










### Seminar on 'Research methodology of Social Sciences'






# WEBINAR ON EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT: IMPACT OF COVID 19

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
#### TRANSLATING BOUNDARIES: NATION, CULTURE AND BODY






### HOW TO READ A SCIENTIFIC LITERATURE

The team from MANAV sent an email to the head of the institution at Sacred Heart College, Chalakudy requesting to conducting a program on "How to read scientific literature". The Manav Human Atlas project, a collaboration between IISER Pune, Persistent Systems, and the National Centre for Cell Science, in 2019 by the Department of Biotechnology Secretary Dr. Renu Swarup. It is funded by the Department of Biotechnology, this project aims to construct a comprehensive map of the entire human body which will explicitly document

On 7th October 2020 Students attended webinar on how to read scientific literature. The interactive sessions were handled by Dr. Anupama Harshal. She gave an introductory lecture on MANAV, the Human Atlas Initiative. She trained the students how to read research articles and review articles. She acquainted students with research journals. She taught students about the pattern of a scientific paper, it should contain a title, abstract introduction, review of literature, materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusion and references. Through this webinar students gained skill in easy way to read and write scientific literature.

After the webinar the students were asked to attend online evaluation of a scientific paper and English proficiency test. The online test was conducted at a later date. The students were given a few days to complete the evaluation. This involved the reading of a scientific paper based on which questions were to be answered by the students. The questions asked were also used to assess the English proficiency of the student.


The class was divided into 4 groups and each group was provided with a group WhatsApp to discuss during group activities.




#### NATIONAL WEBINAR ON "BLOCKCHAIN TECHNOLOGY"

The department organised a National Webinar on "Blockchain Technology" on 26-02-2021 which helps in the online transactions using new technology with creative minds in this new era of emerging echnologies. Dr V. Karthikeyani, Assistant Professor in Computer Science, Government Arts and Science College, Komarapalayam, Tamilnadu, was the resource person. Dr.Sr. Miranto gave the welcome address. Blockchain technology is a structure that stores transactional records, also known as the block, of the public in several databases, known as the "chain," in a network connected through peer-to-peer nodes.
