Report of the activities in 2020

Date - September - October 2020

The Department of History offers the Open Course named Heritage Studies for the students as part of their Semester V courses. This course is offered to students from other departments. The course contains studies on different cultural aspects of the nation and the state. Inspired by the theoretical perspectives taught in the course, students are motivated to conduct studies and research on the heritage elements in their nearby and to create a detailed Documentary video to be streamed through the YouTube channel. If the information and knowledge students earned are shared with the public through digital media, it will help in a better understanding of the cultural characteristics of the locality. This Documentary Series is created as part of the extension and outreach initiative of the Department of History through a digital platform. The students have made a great effort in accessing different places and people despite Covid situations. The students can prepare documentaries individually or they can do them as a group activity.



Report of the Activities in 2021

Date of activity - October 2021 onwards.

This year, the Department of History offered the Open Course named Historical Tourism for the students as part of their V Sem course. The course requires the students to have a great deal of awareness among the students regarding the heritage and natural characteristics of different places in India and particularly in Kerala and its local areas. The creation of documentary is a part of the extension activity by the department through digital platform.
