


# Analysis of Teachers' Feedback









## Feedback Analysis Report of Staff

1. The affiliating university has modified the syllabus and has introduced components that are comparable internationally. This is more so in certain programmes and courses. 61% of faculty agree that the syllabus is on par with international standards while 37% disagree.
2. The University has reduced some parts of the syllabus in certain courses but there is a lack of uniformity in this regard. Moreover certain chapters



from the PG syllabus have been added to the UG syllabus in certain core courses. 51% of staff disagree that time limit prescribed by the University is sufficient for timely and smooth delivery of the syllabus. 45% are happy with the time given.

3. Majority of the faculty (55%) are of the opinion that the syllabus is well organised. 27% feel that the syllabus warrants much more improvements to facilitate more interesting and smooth delivery.
4. Suggested books and reference materials are fairly relevant and exhaustive in most programmes as well as courses. 49 % faculty agree to this while 16% expressed the opposite.
5. The college has a fairly well-stocked library accessible to both staff and students. 73% of staff are happy with the availability of reference materials in the library. 16% however are in favour of upgraded availability.
6. Certain new courses and the incorporation of courses like Research Methodology and currently relevant papers have generally set the mood for sparking research interests among students, though there is much room for improvement. 65% agree that the research perspective can be inculcated among students within the framework of the current syllabus. ( especially due to the project work to be done during the sixth semester).
7. The college provides the right ambience for effective delivery of the syllabus. 76% of faculty face no issues in this regard. Only a minority (0.05%) feel otherwise.
8. The teaching staff are fully supported by the administrative staff in all matters related to job approval, salaries, promotions, service-related problems etc. Around 73% of faculty are of the opinion that the administrative staff is supportive and helpful.
9. Timely and effective interaction with the management is ensured through staff meetings, HOD meetings, governing body meetings, departmental meetings convened by the Principal on a regular basis. Any urgent issues are tackled and discussed using these platforms. 75% agree that this is the tradition at the institution. Only 0.05% disagree.



10. The management encourages the faculty in attending seminars/webinars, presenting papers in national/international conferences, faculty development programmes, becoming members of professional bodies, publishing research papers and books etc. 67% of staff are of the opinion that they get maximum support from the college.
11. Classrooms, smart classrooms, ICT facilities and laboratories are all quite sufficient. Problems arise only when University Examinations have to be conducted in the campus during the academic year. The college is an examination centre for private registration students also. 75% of faculty are satisfied with these facilities.
12. Since there are not many PG aided programmes, the college does not have its own research centre. But there are possibilities of research especially in the Science streams. 39% agree that facilities for research exist.
13. Generally staff are satisfied with the drinking water facility and washrooms provided in the institution. 72% agree to this.
14. Majority of the faculty are of the view that the college maintains cleanliness throughout the year. The efforts taken by the management towards this end are totally acknowledged.
15. 71% of faculty are happy with the maintenance of the laboratories and classrooms.
16. 86% of staff agree that library facilities are adequate though some are of the view that it should be improved.
17. Almost all faculty expressed the opinion that the campus was safe and secure.
18. 85% of faculty agree that the internet facility provided is adequate and facilitates the teaching-learning process.

  
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
