The colony is situated in the Vellikulangara reserve forest in Kerala. The original colony was devastated in a landslide on july 14th 2005. Several people lost their lives in the disaster. The remaining tribesmen were relocated to the present colony at Sasthampoovam.

The intention of the visit was to set up a library for the children of Anappantham tribal colony. By visiting these areas, students can understand the cultural and social life of the tribal people. It helps the students to develop a sense of social commitment. Our students interacted with these people and they are very loving in nature. Our students donated story books, charts, cartoon books, painting books to the childrens of the Anganawadi. It was with the help of our student alumnae, Ms Neenu Thomas arranged the travelling facilities for arranging this place.

The visit also intended to create an awareness among the parents and children of the tribal colony about the importance of education. Our aim was to bring them into the mainstream of the society. Our students inspired and motivated the childrens of Anappantham.
