
Report of the activity



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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENTS OF ECONOMICS, SACRED HEART COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, CHALUKUDY, KERALA AND THE BHOPAL SCHOOL OF SOCIAL SCIENCES, BHOPAL

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote and enhance the academic interest, research and continuing education between the Departments of Economics, Sacred Heart College for Women, Chalukudy, Kerala (hereafter SHC) and The Bhopal School of Social Sciences, Bhopal (hereafter BSSS) have come to an agreement to collaborate to achieve the following objectives:

1. To establish a close and continuing interaction to promote the quality of education between the two institutions.

2. To facilitate the exchange of students as well as faculties for providing wider and broader teaching and learning experiences.

 To provide a platform for academic interaction between the two institutions by delivering special lectures on topics of relevance to improvising quality of higher education.

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- 4. To make available necessary support in organizing the webinars / workshops / seminars /conferences /personality development programmes/ professional Development Programmes/Capacity Building Programmes for enhancement of skills of students, faculties and staff of two institutes; using blended learning modes.
- 5. To assist each other in successfully conducting training, placement and research.
- Exchange of information on research, teaching, E-learning materials and other literature relevant to educational and research programmes of both the Departments.
- 7. To allow for using the academic infrastructure to the students and faculties of all the two institutes subject to its availability and the approval from the head of the institutes as per the norms of the institutes and management.

8. Joint proposal development and engagement in research and/or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies and extending invitation to each other's faculty and students to participate therein.

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 To jointly explore the possibility for providing the consultancy services to the industries and institutions for issues pertaining to various functional areas of the faculty members.

Co-operation and development of activities may extend to any fields and subjects in which the above two Departments may identify shared interests. Both the parties shall designate the co-ordinators who will be responsible for co-operation and implementation of this agreement.

- 1. Each PARTY shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this agreement. Neither PARTY shall make a claim against the other PARTY for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the PARTIES.
- 2. Any research publications and intellectual property rights arising out of the students- and joint research projects shall be jointly published and, when patented, will be jointly and equally owned by SHC and BSSS.
 - 2.1 The procedural formalities for securing and maintaining the intellectual property rights shall be the responsibility of both SHC & BSSS and the expenditure incurred thereof shall be borne jointly and equally by SHC and BSSS.
 - 2.2 The upfront fee and royalty accrued from licensing of any intellectual property arising from this collaboration to other PARTY [IES] shall be shared between the PARTIES, the terms and conditions of which shall be the subject matter of a separate agreement between the PARTIES.
- 3. The PARTIES shall not assign any rights and obligations to any third PARTIES without written consent of the other party.
- 4. Each PARTY shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this agreement. Neither PARTY shall make a claim against the other PARTY for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the PARTIES.
- 5. The PARTIES shall not use any of the confidential information which is required to be held in confidence for any purpose other than performance of their obligations under this understanding.
- 6. This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the PARTIES and shall be valid for five years. This understanding may be amended by mutual written

agreement and may be terminated at any time by either PARTY upon one month's written notice to the other PARTY.

- 7. All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of this agreement may be continued until their completion under the terms of this understanding.
- 8. No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the PARTIES and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed unless otherwise agreed to.
- 9. The relationship of the PARTIES under this understanding shall be non-exclusive and both PARTIES are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. All the parties recognise that this collaboration establishes a foundation of mutual understanding and interest and does not in itself entail any legal and/or financial obligations for either party.

The above MoU holds valid until any or all of the parties to it, withdraw in writing from the same.
