Following the workshop on "How to read scientific literature" on 7th October 2020, MANAV took an initiative to help the students go on to the next level of reading and comprehension of scientific literature. For this the students were asked to register under a faculty coordinator through whom they can submit a self-assessment module on a subject of their choice. MANAV was only offering 3 subjects as a part of this exercise that is microbiology, biochemistry and pharmacology.


The students of the department of Zoology completed the MANAV - Scientific reading and comprehension self-assessment module. 32 students of the department of Zoology participated in this program. It was conducted between September to October of 2021. Dr. V. Neetha was the faculty coordinator of this self-assessment module.

MANAV – Human Atlas is an initiative of the Department of Biotechnology where the government aims to create a database for scientific literature.

The students were asked to answer several questions regarding scientific reading. In the first module their English language comprehension skills were tested. In the second module the students were asked to read a scientific paper which was given to them by team MANAV. The students could choose from three subjects (Biochemistry, Microbiology and Pharmacology) provided.

Before the actual event several online classes and interactions were conducted, first between the coordinator and representatives of MANAV on how to conduct the self assessment module. Several lectures and material such as online youtube manual was provided to the students. Several questions raised by the participants were also cleared by representatives of MANAV.




