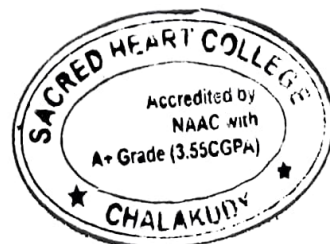


STUDENT FEEDBACK REPORT 2019-20

- A. The survey was conducted via online mode using Google forms. The feedback form was sent to students through whatsapp by teachers for the year 2020. The academic year to be evaluated was 2019-20.
- B. The main index of this questionnaire was :
- Performance of teachers
 - Standard of teaching, level of understanding, syllabus completion, use of ICT etc.
 - Internal evaluation and assessments.
 - Motivation from teachers.
 - Quality Of mentorship.
 - Infrastructure facilities.
 - Career placements.

Findings of the survey:

- Total no of complete responses = 492 .
- Students shared positive responses to the question coverage of syllabus and preparation of teachers for the classes (90%)
- In the evaluation of the communication of teachers, 85% of the students voted positively, but still there is a need for improvement.
- With regard to the communication regarding the assignments of students, only 81% of students shared a positive review where there is need for change.
- Opportunities for internships,field visits,student exchanges were marked only 73% on the positive side. Internships and student exchanges have to be promoted.
- The mentoring system is to be strengthened as some students have given negative reviews although positive are in majority. The review of the role of the Professional Counsellor needs to be taken separately.
- Teachers need to make more efforts to convey the knowledge of Programme and course outcomes.
- Student-teacher interaction needs to be improved as only 75% of students rated positively.
- With regard to the question of use of ICT-enabled learning, teachers need to equip more technology in their teaching process.

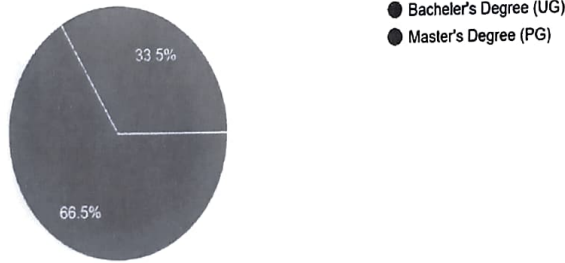


- 10. More extra-curricular activities are to be conducted in the college as only 77 % of students have rated positively.

- 12. Career guidance and placement drives need to be improved, the student support initiatives and the career guidance classes are to be conducted more often for different departments as the major suggestions.
- 13. The overall rating of the college and its teaching-learning process is high with 85% of students given a rating of 4 & 5.

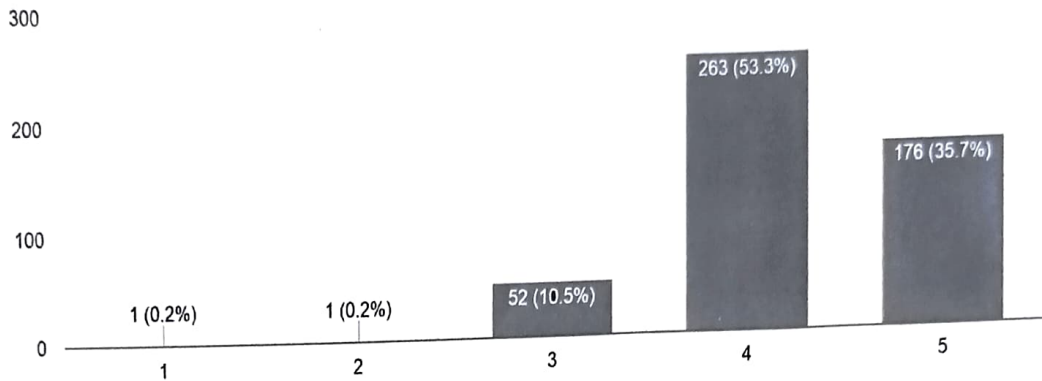

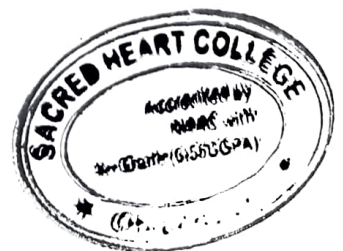

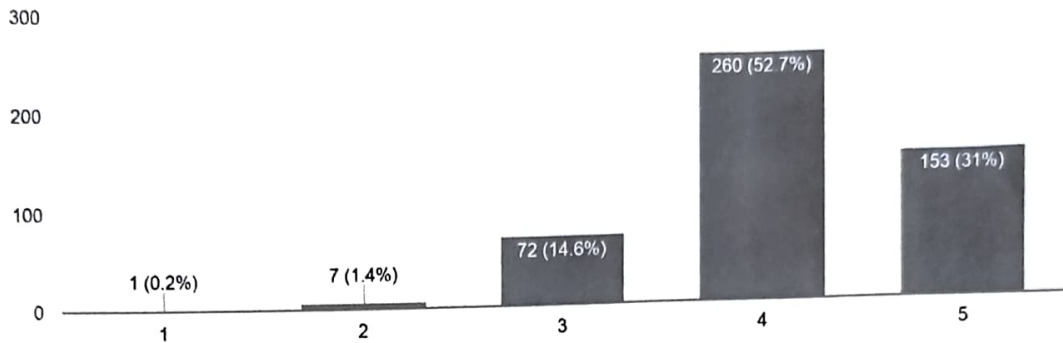

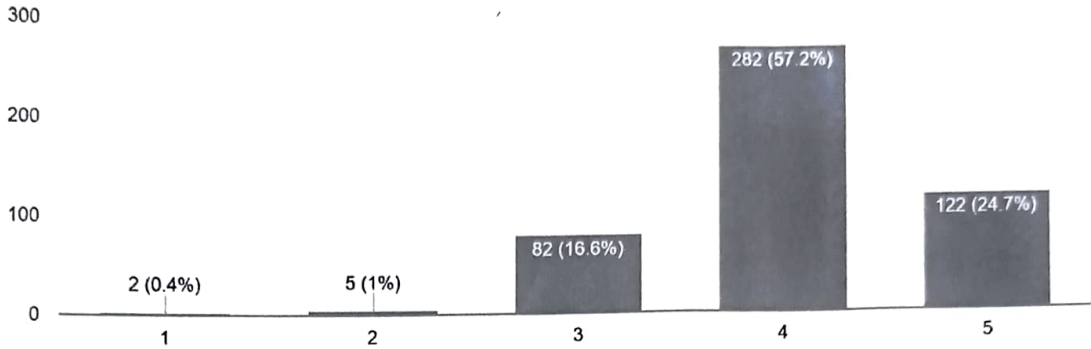

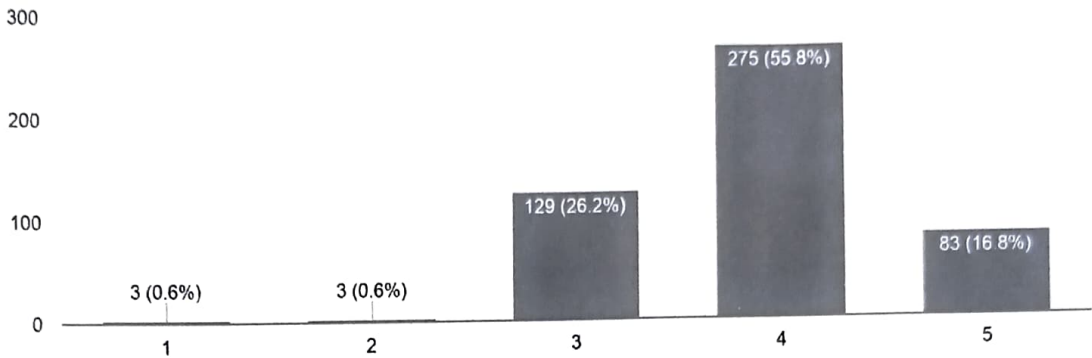

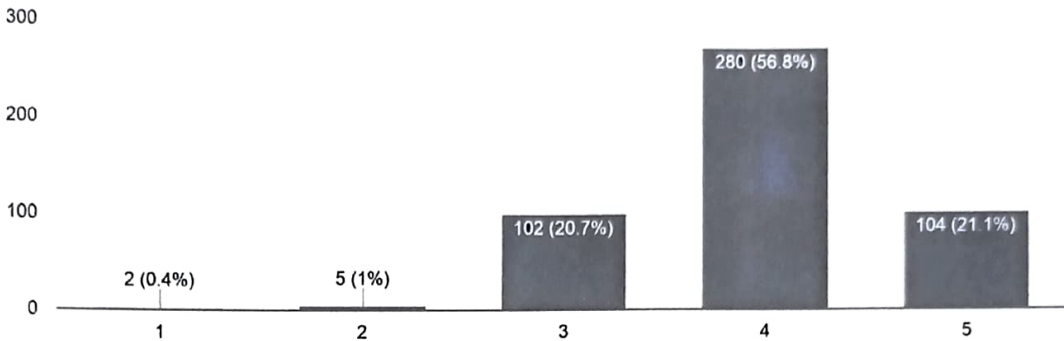

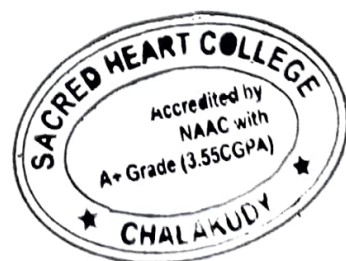

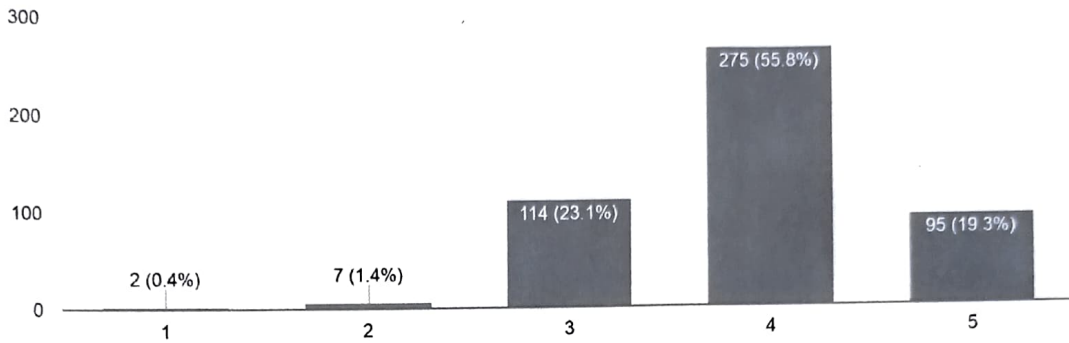

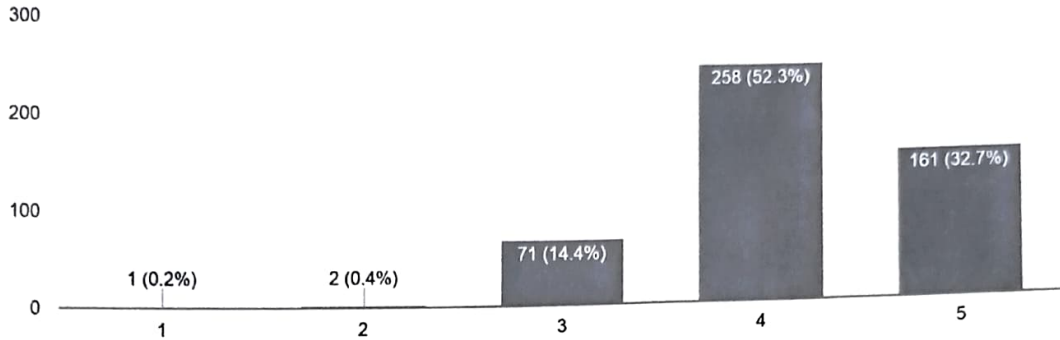
